ADM's first ever PhD Research Festival **Inside/Out** is taking place in January 2018.

**Inside/Out** invites PhD researchers **at all stages** from across the Arts, Design and Media faculty to join the festival line-up to **present / discuss / exhibit / perform their research**.

**Inside/Out** offers a space for researchers to socialise, have fun and disseminate **internal** ideas and 'work-in-progress' to get them **out** there to a supportive mixed audience.

We invite you to join the line-up in three ways:

### **ONE: INSIDE//OUT TALKS**

Informal short talks that share your ongoing research in the form of 20 slides x 15 seconds each.

Inspired by the PechaKucha\* approach, **Inside / Out** talks aim to stimulate discussion and debate amongst festival-goers, maximize the impact of your research and create a dynamic flow of proceedings.

### **TWO: OPEN-MIC SLOTS**

We invite you to join the line up with a 5 Minute provocation to share your ongoing research. The way you present your research is up to you.

### **THREE: POSTER PRESENTATIONS**

Poster presentations of A2 and above to present your research in a visual and/or textual format.

To join our festival line-up tell us please tell us in 280 characters what you'd like to present along with a supporting image or slide.

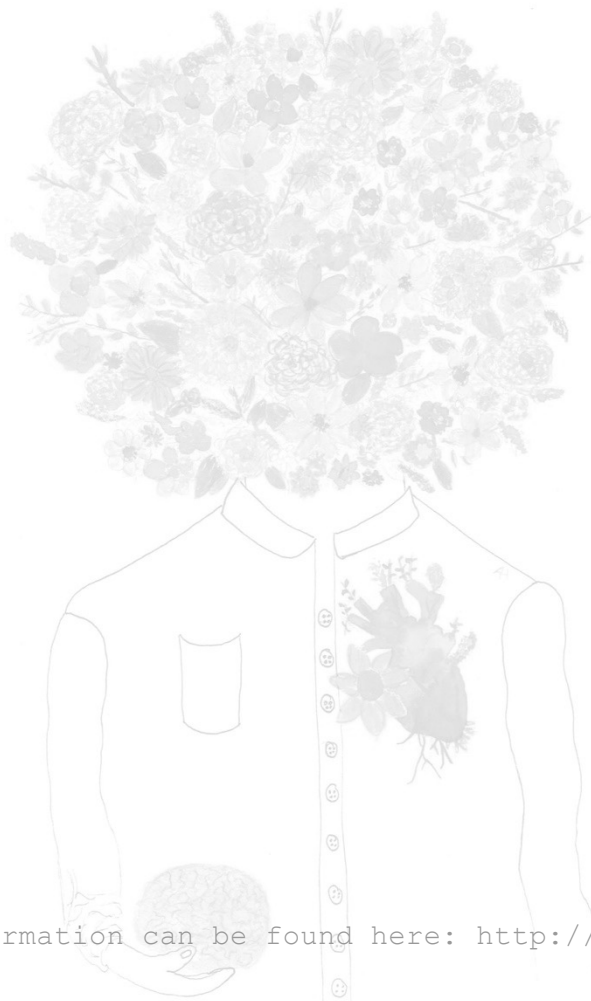
In addition to this, please include:
