ONE: TALKS

Informal short talks in the form of 20 slides x 15 seconds each totalling **5 minutes**. A fast-paced and dynamic format to engage the audience in your research. Slides are automated!

TWO: OPEN-MIC

A **5 minute** provocation to share your research. The way you present is entirely up to you.

THREE: POSTERS

Poster presentations of A2 and above to articulate your research in a textual and/or visual format. Help festival-goers engage with your poster with a **5 minutes** talk.
